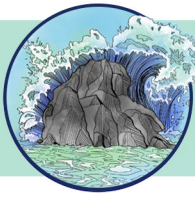

LIFE GROUPS DISCUSSION GUIDE

DANGER IN DISGUISE 2 Peter 2:1–10

March 7, 2021

CONNECT

1. Have you ever been scammed? What happened? How was it disguised?

CELEBRATE

2. Not everyone who claims to speak for God is truly of God. How can you discern the difference between biblical teachers and false teachers/prophets?
3. Read 2 Peter 2:1–3. What did Peter point out about false teachers? What are some ways we can be discerning of these kinds of dangers?
4. Read the truths we hold to as part of the Evangelical Free Church: [What We Believe](#)
 - Which of these truths are difficult for you to believe?
 - What false teachings are you susceptible to that contradict these truths?
5. Look for the four “ifs” in 2 Peter 2:4–8. If they are true, then what (2:9–10)?
6. In our cultural climate, people who affirm God is love sometimes do not also affirm He is judge. How does it sit with you that judgment is coming but rescue is possible? What does the Bible say?
7. According to the Bible, how is rescue possible? Tell each other the gospel and discuss what grace through Jesus entails (Ephesians 2:1–10, Titus 2:1–14).

CONTRIBUTE

7. Spend time in prayer for the church to stand firm in the truth of Jesus:
 - Pray for our church leaders to teach the truth of God’s Word.
 - Pray for our congregation to hunger for and cling to the truth.
 - Pray for those who have been harmed by false teachers.
