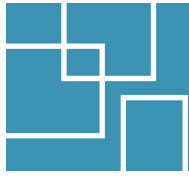

1. What generation are you part of and what are the distinctives/stereotypes of it? In what ways do you fit those?
2. How do your generational instincts affect your expectations of and engagement in the Church?
3. Read Psalm 78:1–8. Pray for the Holy Spirit to give you open hearts to God's vision shared in this passage.
 - Whose responsibility is it to reach the next generation (vs 4–5)?
 - What outcomes does the psalmist say will unfold for the next generation when this happens effectively (vs 6–8)?
4. What's the difference between mission, message and method? Which should never be compromised? Which must change over time?
5. Take a look at Judges 2:6–10, focusing on verse 10. How do you think the baton handoff between generations is going currently in the Church at large? What about in New Hope Church?
6. What are some ways you feel we can better integrate generations at New Hope Church?
7. What are some ways you feel we can better reach the next generations?
