DISTINCTION Galatians 4

CONNECT

1. If you suddenly discovered that you were going to inherit millions of dollars five years from now, how would you feel? How would it change your life?

GOING DEEPER

- 2. Read Galatians 4:1–3. What were we enslaved to before Christ? How did these things hold us back? (See Galatians 3:23–24)
- 3. Read Galatians 4:4–5. What status did Christ find us in? What did He redeem us into? How eagerly does Jesus want you to receive these things?
- 4. Read Galatians 4:6–7. How does God want you to address Him? What did He do to make communication with Him possible for you? How does God react when you call him "Father"?
- 5. Read Galatians 4:11. What emotion do you suppose Paul feels in this verse? What is his concern for the church? Read Galatians 4:8–10. What is the cause of Paul's concern? What is at stake?
- 6. Read Galatians 4:21–31. Who are we? Why is this important? How will we live if we are confused about who we are?

ACTION

- 7. Paul is adamant that we are not made right with God through human effort, yet we keep falling into that trap. How have you, personally, felt the pull of human effort? Do you ever feel closer to God when you "perform" well? What specific actions lead you to this temptation?
- 8. Most religions operate on the basis of works—if you do the right things, you'll be spiritual. Against this backdrop, what makes the gospel of Jesus so attractive? How can we shine this light into the world around us?
