CONNECT

1. What image comes to mind when you think of the word “abide”? Read John 15:1–17.
2. When did your relationship with Jesus begin? What are some of the highlights of that relationship?

GOING DEEPER

3. What do you find encouraging about verses 1–5?
4. How does Psalm 80:8–9 and Isaiah 5:7 describe the vine imagery?
5. Do you really believe you can do nothing without Christ? How do your thoughts and actions affirm this mentality? How fruitful have you been without Him?
6. Describe a time in your life when God pruned you so you would grow closer to Him. Was it a good process? Why or why not? What was the result of the pruning?
7. What role does the Holy Spirit play in our pruning and fruit-bearing process?
