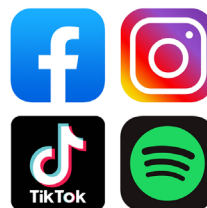

## PHILIP Acts 8:3–8

### CELEBRATE

1. Describe a time when you were moved out from your comfort zone to sharing the gospel (i.e., vacation, traveling, out of your home)?

### CONNECT

2. Read 2 Kings 17; Ezra 4; and Nehemiah 4. What elements of Israel's history led to a hatred of the Samaritans? How does the gospel message overcome such entrenched divisions?
3. Read 1 Corinthians 12:12–26; Galatians 3:23–29; Ephesians 4:1–6; and Colossians 3:1–11. What does the Bible say about unity in the church? How would you describe the basis for your unity with other Christians?
4. In what ways can you actively preserve the spiritual unity that already exists among believers?
5. How does Jesus' interaction in Samaria (Jn. 4) overcome social constructs?

### CONTRIBUTE

6. What may be some fears or concerns about sharing the gospel?
7. Read Romans 10:14–17. Why is evangelism and sending missionaries important in fulfilling the Great Commission?
8. What kind of pressures do you face that prevent you from sharing your testimony with others?
9. When the believers were scattered to different geographic regions, they did not cease to evangelize. How can you make the most of the opportunities to evangelize where you are today?
