

SEEK THE LORD Psalm 105:4

CONNECT

1. What are your prevailing hopes for 2023?

GOING DEEPER

2. Read Psalm 105:4. The word “seek” appears twice, but in the Hebrew it is two different words. The first “seek” means to consult or inquire. What can it look like for you to consult the Lord, to inquire of Him, especially as we step into a new year?
3. There is a particular reference to the Lord’s strength. How might you inquire of or consult the Lord’s strength? What does this mean?
4. The second “seek” means to search, touch or interrogate. Also, in the Hebrew language, the word for “presence” literally means “face.” Practically speaking, what does it mean for you to search or touch the face of the Lord?
5. How might you do these things “continually” as the text suggests?

ACTION

6. As we transition from 2022 to 2023, what are the points of gratitude and expectation you can express to the Lord? What will it look like for you to do this?
7. How can you use Psalm 105:4 to share the gospel with someone? Who will that someone be and when?
