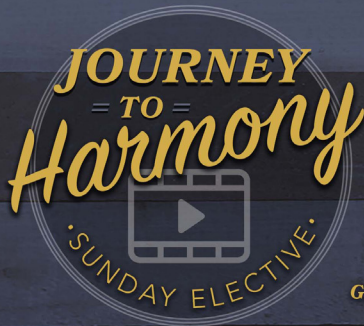

CONNECT

1. What comes to your mind when you think of a generous person?

2. In what way is the generosity of God on display in our daily lives?
3. How do we display generosity to others in our own lives?
4. As disciples how does the example of Jesus' life inspire our own generosity?
5. Deuteronomy 26:5–10 serves as a credal statement of the Hebrew people—a declaration of their story. Write your own credal statement. Consider including the matter of your own generosity.

ACTION

6. Deuteronomy 26:11 highlights people to be blessed by generosity. How does this motivate you as you relate to others?
7. Read Deuteronomy 26:12–15 and Acts 2:45–46. What do these passages reveal about the heart of God for broken communities?
