THE SONG OF SONGS Song of Solomon 1:1

CONNECT

1. When have you felt well loved (by a parent, a friend, a family member, a spouse)?

CELEBRATE

2. What did you know about the Song of Solomon before hearing the message?
Why should we be studying this book in church?
3. Read Ephesians 5:25–32. How can human romance teach us about our relationship with Christ?
