

Care Seminar: Freedom from Your Past



DISCUSSION GUIDE

October 23, 2022

THE LORD'S UNFAILING LOVE Malachi 1:2-5

CONNECT

1. What's your favorite part about fall? What are some ways that the changing of seasons proclaim God's faithfulness and the certainty of His promises?

GOING DEEPER

- 2. Read Malachi 1:1–5. Pray together for the Holy Spirit to give you open hearts and minds to how God wants to work in your lives through this passage.
- 3. What is the story of Jacob and Esau, and how does it connect to what was happening in Malachi 1?
- 4. Read Obadiah 10–11. Why did God bring judgment on the Edomites? How is that evidence of God's love for Israel? Does that fit with our culture's understanding of what love is?
- 5. How would you define the love of God?
- 6. What experiences or circumstances have caused you to doubt God's love?

ACTION

- 7. In verse 5, God's greatness is promised to extend beyond Israel's borders. What sorts of boundaries or limits do we put on God's work and fame? Imagine what it would look like for Him to truly reign over all.
- 8. What's one way this passage impacts you? How are you challenged, convicted or encouraged?
