- Help pioneer new ways for NHC to engage and disciple unchurched students in our surrounding community
- Recruit, train and shepherd volunteers who share the vision of Student Ministries
- Help create an environment that is welcoming to families with diverse cultural and language backgrounds
- Assist in creating and administrating Student Ministries budget to maximize ministry impact
