

MINNEAPOLIS, MN - 2019

Dates: June 26-28

Ages: Students completing grades 6-12

Cost: \$150 (\$50down payment due with application; remaining \$100 due June 17)

Space: Limited to 25 students

Application Deadline: March 6 – Must include a \$50 down payment.

WHY MINNEAPOLIS?

Christians are called to live on mission every day, not just for a week or two in the summer when they are on a mission trip. There is a great spiritual need in the city and suburbs of Minneapolis; our home. With the number of churches in our community this should not be the case. Students will have opportunities to discover ministries already at work around us and have a chance to meet the needs in our community by serving others and pointing them to Jesus.

WHAT WILL MY STUDENT BE DOING?

We will be together for 3 days and 2 nights. Students will spend one day serving locally through NHC ministries like our Food Shelf. We'll spend a day focused on the city where we'll partner with Gospel Life Church to serve and reach out to their local community. For the Global focus day, we'll be partnering with the Freedom Truck to raise support and awareness for ministries that fight human trafficking.

In our evenings and mornings together, we'll be in God's word focusing on God's call to "go" and His empowering Spirit which makes it possible. Students will also be challenged to take responsibility for themselves. This will include taking turns cooking meals, cleaning up, packing lunches, cleaning the facility, and spending time in God's word and then sharing about that time with the group.
