CONNECT

1. What comes to mind when you imagine the throne room in heaven?
2. Read Revelation 4:1–8 together. What are some songs you know that capture this scene?

CELEBRATE

3. What does the word “holy” mean? What does it mean for God to be declared, “Holy, holy, holy”? Where else in Scripture do we see that declaration?
4. Take a few minutes together to memorize the song from Revelation 4:8b.
5. Think about this song on a corporate level for the community of New Hope Church. How has God shown Himself to be the Almighty?
6. Process this song personally and think back to where you were one year ago. How has God been Almighty?
7. Consider what you are facing in this coming year. Where do you need God to be Almighty? Pray for those needs together.

CONTRIBUTE

8. Look back at Jesus’ invitation in Revelation 4:1. Imagine Jesus, who has opened the heavens to us (Hebrews 10:20) looking you directly in the eyes and saying, “Come up here!” What does it look like for you to respond to Him? What are some practical ways you could pursue Him this year?
