DISCUSSION questions

1. Tell about a time when you did a good thing with a bad motivation.
2. In Luke 10, Martha is engaged in good and necessary activity. Yet, the position of her heart is called into question by Jesus. Discuss the differences between “good activity” and “good activity flowing out of love.”
3. Have you ever fallen into the trap of comparing yourself to others as you follow and serve Jesus? What are the ungodly motivations underneath this?
4. What do you think it looks like to sit “at the Lord’s feet” as a disciple in 2016?
5. Psalm 84 is a psalm that describes the glories of being in the presence of God—sitting at his feet, in a sense. Read and pray through this psalm together.
