DISCUSSION questions

1. What is worship? What role do our Sunday gatherings have in your understanding of worship? How does your Monday–Saturday life inform your definition? How does emphasizing one of these categories over the other detract from a healthy understanding of what worship is?
2. Read Colossians 3:12–17. In light of the “other-ness” of this passage (bearing with, forgiving, etc), how might you apply the “whatever you do” command in your relationships with others in your workplace? Your home? Our church family?
3. What’s one “aha!” moment you’ve experienced through the teaching of the God@Work series? How would this inform your answer to the question, “Why do you go to work?”
4. How are you desiring to apply your “aha!” moment in a practical way in your work going forward? Pray for each other in regard to these good desires.
5. If you know it, close your time together by singing the Doxology together:
*“Praise God from whom all blessings flow
Praise Him, all creatures here below
Praise Him above, ye heavenly hosts
Praise Father, Son and Holy Ghost. Amen.”*
