DISCUSSION questions

1. What are some “either/or” realities we deal with? (for instance, Vikings vs. Packers and Republican vs. Democrat, etc.)
2. Speaking of either/or, in the unfortunate divide of pro-life vs. racial justice, which side have you tended towards? What are the factors that have landed you there? What would it look like for you to embrace both of these biblical justice issues?
3. Read Ephesians 4:1–6, 29–32. In what practical ways are we encouraged to express the gospel to one another? How should these actions impact your life in relationships with those from other ethnic, political, cultural or economic backgrounds?
4. What’s one practical step you will take to pursue issues of justice for the “other side of the equation” than you’ve typically leaned toward? Ask the Holy Spirit to help you overcome fear or anxiety as you respond.
