Discussion Questions

- 1. Take a few minutes to set the scene. Who was the message of Haggai delivered to? What were some significant markers in their history that frame their current circumstances?
- 2. Look at Deuteronomy 28, focusing on the blessings in verses 1, 4–5, 11–12 and the curses in verses 15, 17–18, 22.
 - · How do we see that playing out in Haggai 1?
 - What circumstances in your life is God allowing or bringing about in order to turn your heart toward Him? How are you responding to those?
- 3. While Haggai's audience was called to rebuild God's physical house, we now carry that story forward by building God's spiritual house (Ephesians 2:19–22). Reflect on the opportunities God has given you right now. Where are you called to become a builder of God's glory and influence?
- 4. The Israelites had a number of excuses and distractions (even some good things!) that kept them from becoming builders. What are common things that get in the way for you?
- 5. As you consider becoming a builder of God's glory and influence, what's one step you can take to say "yes" to that this week?
