## Discussion Questions

1. What era of your life would you consider your “glory days?” What about your spiritual “glory days?” What’s going on in your relationship with God right now that in five years you’ll look back on in the same way?
2. What have you been led to do for God’s kingdom but have responded with, “So and so is already doing that” or “That person is better at this”? How has this kind of comparison squelched your desire to build and kept you from obeying?
3. Read Haggai 2:4 with Matthew 28:18–20. Read the last sentence again. In what ways does Jesus’ presence with us inform our perspective and empower us to carry out this commission?
4. How would you articulate what God has called New Hope Church to build? What role can your group have in saying “yes” to what God is building through us?
5. Read Galatians 6:9. In what area of building are you most in need of encouragement to not grow weary? Pray for one another.

**Family Question:** What are you building as a family? How does the way you’re using your relationships, time, money, talents and spiritual gifts point to this? What adjustments can you make so that these priorities point to the fact that you’re building God’s kingdom?
