### Discussion Questions

1. Think of a time when you visited a very familiar place only to discover something new that you had never noticed before (a vacation spot, Grandma's house or an old college campus). Share your thoughts and feelings about what you discovered.
2. Read Isaiah 40:9. What do you learn about what a shepherd does? Correlate that to Psalm 23:1 and give special thought to what it means for God to be your shepherd. How can that play itself out in your life?
3. Consider the shift in tone from "The Lord is my shepherd" to "The Lord is shepherding me." What is the significance, if any, of that shift? How does that shape your thinking about the way God's care is manifested in your life?
4. See yourself with God in every image of this beautiful psalm. Which line is most meaningful to you and why?
5. Memorize Psalm 23 with your Life Group and/or family.
