



## **Make a Joyful Noise**

### **Discussion Questions**

1. Take time to recall a meaningful moment of worship, either private or in a gathering. What makes that moment significant to you? Share the experience with your Life Group and/or family.
2. What are things in your life that you assign worth (“worth-ship”) that may compete with the Lord? Why?
3. Carefully read through Psalm 98. List every reference to God’s person, character or work. What does the abundance of references say about the true object of worship?
4. In the message, Pastor Matthew said, “God saves and the response is praise.” Read 1 Peter 1:3–9 comparing it to Psalm 98. Explore the correlation between the salvation God provides sinners and “rejoicing with joy that is inexpressible” as we see in 1 Peter 1:8.
5. What would it look like for your Life Group to incorporate some regular rhythm of worship?

Family Question: Based on what you have learned from Psalm 98, how will you and your family approach next weekend’s worship gatherings differently?
