Discussion Questions

1. Boaz is described as “a worthy man” in Ruth 2:1. If someone were to describe you in three words, what would they say?
2. On any given Sunday God can and does speak to His people through the preaching of His Word. Can you recall a particular message when God spoke specifically to you? Share this with your group.
3. In verse 2, Ruth goes to find the one “in whose sight [she] shall find favor.” Read Ephesians 1:3-14. Discuss all the ways this passage says that God has granted you favor as His child. Take time to respond with prayers of thanksgiving.
4. Do you use language like “fortunate,” “chance” or “coincidental” when God is actually working behind the scenes to bring about His provision?
5. Is there a situation in your life right now where, like Ruth, God is calling you to act, work, speak, be involved or get your hands messy even as He is at work (Philippians 2:12-13)? Pray together asking God for courage, skill and the opportunity to step into these situations.

Family Question: How has God used the obedience of someone else to providentially and kindly provide for our family?
