Discussion Questions

1. Pull out a dollar bill and visit wheresgeorge.com. Type in the serial number and find out how often this dollar has been spent.
2. What does it mean to “render to Caesar the things that are Caesar’s?” Read Jeremiah 29:7. How do we as a church of Christ-followers live this out?
3. What does it mean to render “to God the things that are God’s?” Read Genesis 1:27 and Romans 8:29. How do we obey this command? This past week, how have you spent yourself for the glory of God and the advancement of His kingdom?
4. How do you feel about the thought of being God’s “currency” that He can spend as He desires? Discuss both your positive and negative reactions.
5. Read Isaiah 43:1-7 and highlight each promise that God makes to His people. How do these promises affect your view of God? How far are you willing to be spent by the God who makes these promises? Close by praying through the promises, thanking God for them and choosing to trust Him with them.
