Discussion Questions

1. After David was chosen to be king, he ended up waiting more than 20 years before that fully became a reality. Read Psalm 13 together with David's long season of waiting in mind.
2. Take a look at verses 1–2. Can you relate to what David was feeling? When have you experienced those kinds of questions toward God?
3. Of the four key things David demonstrates about waiting, which comes most naturally for you? Which tends to be more difficult?
4. When you look back at the past five years, where do you see God's proven goodness? What has He brought you through?
5. If you trace the road you're on right now, would it be straight or winding? What have been the potholes, unexpected turns and scenic overlooks? What's the "point B" that you're waiting to get to and how can David's posture in Psalm 13 help in your journey?
