Discussion Questions

1. When you have good news to share, what's your favorite way to connect with others to spread the word?
2. Today's message was about connection. Are you as connected as you'd like to be? How would you like to be connected? How have you tried to connect with others?
3. Read Matthew 22:37–39. We are called to love God supremely and others as ourselves. What would you identify in your own life as the strongest competitors for your affection? A challenge this week: Place your phone out of reach while eating and actively engage with those around you.
4. Read Matthew 28:18–20. Are all Christians called to share the gospel? Why are both our words and actions essential parts of this? What impact would a church have on their community by loving their neighbors, both individually and collectively?
5. When have you made an "all in" commitment? How can you commit yourself to serving Jesus on His mission this week? What next steps is the Lord leading you to take in response to this message—Visit New Connections? Join or facilitate a Life Group? Other ideas?
